



Parent Feedback Analysis -2016-17

Majority of the Thiru. Vi. Ka Government Arts college students are first generation learners and their parents are not educated. Hence, it is always difficult to collect feedback from the parents. Some of the parents who willingly come forward to give their feedback are noted and analysed. We don't compel the parents if they hesitate to provide the feedback.

This academic year we could collect 123 parent feedback forms and analyze the three questions that gave insight on curriculum.

About 92 percent of the Parents stated that they were happy with the overall development of their wards in communication skills and technical skills. However, they were asking why their wards were still not able to communicate in English freely. About 82 percent of the parents surveyed stated that they were astonished to witness the confidence of their wards which provided them self-respect and self-reliance among them and also the family.



Feedback Analysis -2016-17

Total of 69 teaching staff have given feedback about curriculum for the year 2016-17. Since the university is framing the syllabus, the college has limited stack in reforming and restricting the syllabus. However, members of Board of studies from our college will take into account when they frame the syllabus in following year.

Feedback abstract:

- 65% of the staff members strongly agree that the current syllabus is adequate in terms of contemporary relevance of topics, that current scenario and enhances the knowledge of functional areas of management and the specisied contact hours are sufficient to cover the syllabus and they feel that the prescribed reference books are available in the market.
- 30% of staff agree that the content of the syllabus is fulfilling the need of the industry.
- 5% of the staff feel that the syllabus is not fulfilling the need of the industry and there is a gap in between the syllabus and industry expectation.



Alumni of about 380 respondents gave their feedback on curriculum for this academic year 2016-17. The question on future aspirations and job relevance emphasized in their curriculum was agreed by majority of the alumni (89%). Curriculum followed by the institute was also pointed out in positive mode to influence their Inter and intra personal skills during their employment (79%). The questionnaire also reflected the current trends included in the syllabi which was agreed upon by 78 percent of the alumni respondents. Moreover, 67 percent of the respondents stated that the project work and internships during their period of study helped them in employment opportunities.
